Linda was a founding member of Southern Heartland Art Gallery. Having run her own galleries in Naples and Punta Gorta Florida, Linda understood that budding artists were often intimidated by the possibility of rejection when entering the jury process required by most art shows. She envisioned a "Community Art Show," which would provide a format for all artists, beginners to skilled professionals. The show would be judged, but not juried. Thus, thanks to Linda Pflug, Artful Harvest was born.

Faithfully devoted to our gallery and the mission of Southern Heartland Arts, Inc., the nonprofit umbrella organization founded in 1988, Linda acted as mentor to many artists throughout her own professional career. She was the mentor instructor at our free and open to the public "Community Paint Party," held each and every Friday, 10-2. Through Paint Party, Linda created a "family of artists" within Southern Heartland's larger family of artists.






